
Swap the fast forward button for pause.

And if you know someone with four paws, well they're very welcome too.



Breakfast, lunch or dinner, our menus boast classic Scottish cooking with a fresh twist. All complemented by a wine list with over 350 to choose from.


And, while we wouldn't like to make too much of a meal of it, we are quietly proud of our two AA Rosettes.
